Developed by Neil Fleming in the late 1980s. The VARK model helps individuals and educators optimize learning strategies for better comprehension and retention.

- Visual- using mind maps and flowcharts, highlighting key points in different colours, watching videos and infographics;
- Auditory- listen to podcasts or audiobooks, participating debates;
- Reading/writing- take note, reading articles, journals, or instruction manuals, using headings and lists;
- Kinesthetic- engaging in role-playing or simulations, using models or tools to interact with concepts, walking while reviewing notes or learn by heart.
