Limit real-life interaction

Virtual learning may lack the spontaneous conversations and cultural immersion that come with face-to-face interactions. For instance, students in traditional education can attend seminars and discuss their topics with partners or teacher during the lesson while virtual learning are restricted to chatting through websites. Schaeffer and Konetes elucidated that students, who enrolled in an online course, dropping out of their course at a higher rate than students who were in the on-campus program. It is evident from these researches that the attrition rate is higher among online learners as compared to the students of offline courses.

Easier to procrastinate

Students tend to procrastinate even in offline classes but it comes to online classes, it becomes easier. Students will delay joining the classes, will skip class discussions, or remained incomplete assignments because there is no one to remind them about these activities. They are required to do all the activities on their own without any reminders from the instructors, as offline classes. Elvers et al. reported that the likelihood of procrastination was higher in virtual environment as students are prone to procrastinate more when they are not supposed to behave in a particular way for their learning [24].

Self-motivation and discipline

Self-directed learning requires strong motivation and discipline, which some individuals may struggle with. A lack of self-motivation and self-management skills in a student will lead to failure in completing the online course. In addition, the lack of a structured classroom environment might lead to procrastination and inconsistent study habits. As a resulting of that they may feel unmotivated and less communicate with people.

Prolonged screen exposure can lead to health problems

For online classes, a student has to spend hours in front of the screen. This prolonged exposure can lead to many physical and psychological health issues. Recent research has clearly explained that there are some health risks associated to screen time. Wong found that e-learning requires time but has some risk factors attached to an individual's health that brain development and well-being [30].

The literature revealed numerous benefits and limitation of virtual learning environment. Flexible schedule and environment, access to diverse resources, student centered learning reduced costs and increased collaboration, exchange ideas, variety of courses, professional teachers and learning styles, enhanced time management skills, and immediate feedbacks are the critical advantages of digital learning while it also has some











disadvantages as limit life interaction, easier to procrastination, self-motivation, discipline, and prolonged screen exposure cause health problems.
