The digital revolution has significantly transformed the landscape of independent language learning. Stockwell and Hubbard [5] analyze the impact of mobile-assisted language learning (MALL) on independent learners. Their research indicates that mobile applications provide flexibility, accessibility, and personalized learning experiences, making them valuable tools for independent learners.

Godwin-Jones [6] explores the role of online learning platforms, virtual communities, and social media in facilitating independent language learning. These resources not only provide access to authentic materials but also create opportunities for meaningful interaction and communication in the target language.

Uzbek researchers have made significant contributions to the field of independent language learning. Sharipova and Khasanov [7] analyze the effectiveness of blended learning approaches in Uzbek educational contexts, highlighting how combining







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traditional methods with digital tools enhances learner autonomy and motivation among Uzbek students learning English.

Abdullaeva [8] examines the specific challenges faced by Uzbek learners in independent English acquisition, noting cultural and educational factors that influence self-directed learning processes. Her research provides valuable insights into adapting global language learning strategies to the Uzbek context.

RESULTS AND DISCUSSION

Based on the literature review, several key factors emerge as critical for successful independent English language learning. Goal setting and planning significantly enhance learning outcomes, with clear, realistic, and measurable goals providing direction. Breaking down long-term goals into smaller, achievable objectives helps maintain motivation and track progress [3]. Consistent practice through regular exposure to and engagement with the target language is crucial for effective learning, including daily practice routines and integrating English into everyday activities [7]. Using diversified learning resources such as textbooks, online platforms, mobile applications, and authentic materials helps develop comprehensive language skills and maintains learner interest [5]. Addressing all four language skills (reading, writing, listening, speaking) ensures well-rounded language proficiency, requiring independent learners to consciously allocate time for practicing each skill [8].

Modern technology offers numerous tools and platforms that support independent language learning. Language learning applications like Duolingo, Babbel, and Memrise provide structured learning experiences with immediate feedback and gamified elements that enhance motivation [5]. Online platforms and MOOCs such as Coursera, edX, and FutureLearn offer comprehensive language courses designed by educational institutions, providing quality content and structured learning paths [6]. Authentic materials through streaming services, podcasts, news websites, and social media provide access to authentic language use and cultural contexts [6].

The literature identifies several common challenges faced by independent learners. Without external accountability, maintaining motivation can be challenging. Establishing consistent routines, joining online communities, and setting rewards for achieving milestones can help address this issue [3]. Independent learners often struggle to find opportunities for speaking practice. Language exchange platforms, online tutoring services, and voice recording tools offer potential solutions. Without instructor feedback, learners may struggle to identify and correct errors. AI-powered language tools, online communities, and periodic professional assessment can provide necessary feedback. The research by Uzbek scholars highlights specific cultural considerations that impact independent learning in the Uzbek context, including the importance of culturally relevant materials and community-based practice opportunities.
