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

Harmonizing national and universal values in the education of youth:

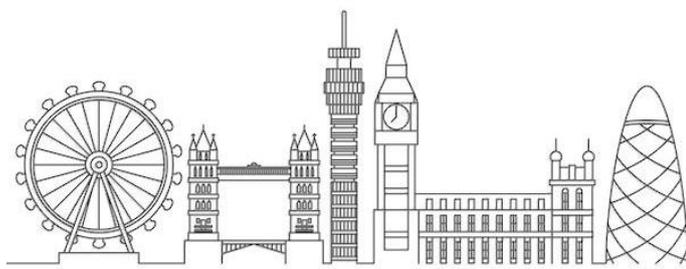
National values, including patriotism, hard work, respect for elders, and care for the younger ones, create a strong moral foundation in young people.
