When ancient people thought about existence, slaughtered myths, wisdom or epics, they commented on the value of the universe, its Infinity, The Universe and human connections, the meaning, content, purpose of human life, and values such as superstition, wisdom, hokisor, goodness, Fidelity, patriotism, and even deified some of them. The theme of values is also reflected in religious worldviews and their oldest forms, each religion has its own system of divine values. Among them, the main books of these religions are the Qur'an, the Bible, the Veda, the Upanishad and others, in which certain systems of divine value are expressed. As the historical forms of religions improved, the value system in them also continued to show new facets. The ancient book of our ancestors is the most vivid example of our religious and philosophical heritage of Avesto, a work in which the universal values of our ancient peoples are illuminated. Since Avesto was the Holy Book of Zoroastrianism, it embodied the value system of this religion. At the same time, the book gives a great place to universal values, their importance for human spirituality and practical activities. In the work, qualities such as goodness, perfection, hurficrity, humanity are shown through the image of Akhuramazda. Zarathustra (Zarathustra), one of the authors of the book, believes that people should follow the forces of good, light, distinguish good from evil, justice from dishonesty, be on the side of Akhuramazda for the rest of their lives. The value of man in this process is reflected in his social activity, in the way he lives, in his spiritual form, in his indifference to the struggle for the victory of good. There are sources on the history of the development of natural-scientific, especially moral values of the peoples who lived on the land of our country in avesto in the pre-Islamic period, which should be studied in greater depth. The theme of values is also clearly expressed in the philosophical-divine doctrine of the "Monian period" (3rd-4th century AD, the founder of which Monius lived 216-276 ad). According to Monius, there are two worlds – the "world of darkness and damage", in the first there is injustice, oppression, violence, and in the second there is a world of literary, indestructible, constant values. The teachings of Monius summarize the basic values of ancient times, the general system of which is expressed in connection with mythology, philosophy, Cosmogony, astronomy and other socio-natural fields of knowledge. Traces of the theme of values are also prominent in the teaching of Mazdak (executed in 51), who lived in the 6th century. Unfortunately, these traces became blurred

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after Islam became the official religion, making them difficult to trace. The VIII-XII centuries are of great importance in the development of views on values in Central Asia. In this dam, Berunius wrote Sadly in his work" relics from ancient rings". Further, when it comes to Kezi, it should be noted that it is doubtful that the values of the civilization of our homeland have also had a great opposite effect on the development of the culture of the Arab world. thinkers such as Horace, Phorobias, Berunius, Ibn-Sino, Ulughbek, zabardast allomas of theological science such as al-Bukhari, at-Termiziy, Kubro, Ahmad Yassawi, Nagshband, Lutfiy, Navoi. In the maturation of such breeds as Babur, Bedil, Mashrab, the influence of the culture and values of not only Islam, but also our civilization is incomparable. It is not for nothing that modern Islamic theologians recognize the works of al-Bukhari as post-Qur'anic Bibles, worship the graves of al-Bukhari, at-Termiziy, Yassawi and Nagshband as sacred shrines! Despite the fact that there are enough sources, the works written about the opposite effect of the civilization of our country on the development of Islam and the development of the culture of the long-standing Islamic countries are still not enough, the need to conduct research on this right has already been reached.
