



In fact, she was the person who played an integral role in developing Muqimi's love and talent for literature. She encouraged his child to enjoy the works of great poets, and writers, such as Alisher Navoi and Hafiz Jami, and introduced him to classical Eastern literature. Muhammad Aminxo'ja Muqimi got his intial education in his own neighbourhood. For his further education he went to Bukhara, the place of knowledge at that time. When he came back, finishing his education, uneducated nobles of the country communicated his him in a such careful way. According to him:

"It was precisely the unpleasant Kokand nobles who made me reconsider my views and develop new moral and literary views in myself. The realization of my disappointment helped me a lot."
